Aug 10th 1849

My dear Brother,

I have no doubt that it will give you pleasure to hear from us I am happy to say that Brother Evans and I and our families are quite well and I hope these few lines will find you the same. I am happy to say that God is with us in converting the heathen in this country for Mr Evans has baptized about two hundred since his arrival here. I have no doubt that this will make your heart jump for joy to hear of so many of your dear Brethren becoming Christians but be by the grace of God expect to see greater things than these. It would do your heart good could you hear them sing and pray for they love the Lord Jesus who died for them and be faithful followers of God their Saviour. I know there are with you your wife and your young men in our heart. I am happy to see that you have made the better choice in joining the English Wesleyans for I think if you go with them they will do you good.
