Samia 6th Jan 1838

On the 3rd of January in the year ¹⁸³⁶ ~~1835~~ there
was an understanding made between Samia Band
and Mr Waldron, the Missionary, that by our giving
150. the School would be partly under our control
and at the Missionary's own suggestion a School
Committee was appointed, ^{one of them} ~~the others~~
are Sokena Mawawoh, ^{Andrew Mageshe and others}
Johnston. ^{was highly pleased with this arrangement at}
Mr Waldron has given us in Council
a fair understanding that we would have a
voice in all matters pertaining to the school, by
this I thought I had a right to express the wish of my
people to Mr Waldron respecting the management
of the school which is altogether a new system
to us. Had I since actually done any thing that
is not right I beg to be forgiven & I'll give
no further trouble on that score.
