Dear Will

do you remember what you said the last night you were here you told me I could tell you everything now for you would never try to give me up again could you know how happy it made me feel that I could count on you and when you told me you would be such an est prayer pr pray that night that you always would be just and true why he said I do not know but Oh how much better I felt after he told me I knew you could not do wrong as I ask God to bless you after you asked me to marry you I made up my mind I would never give you or your children an unkind word I would be so kind to them as it was in my power to be you do not know much I am sure you believe I love you more than your mother could I believe you ever loved me but how unkind to strive to gain my heart then to I cannot write the rest for I love you too much to speak unkind of you I told you what Mr Scott said in my letter I don't think I will live long so marry me and be just to your self and me then I can meet your wife and my God you would not have me lose my soul then marry me and you never shall be sorry if I can help it you told me you would try and save the girls the disgrace if I could see you I would go down on my knees to you for the sake of the rest Mr Gerson was here telling about a girl in the same position as I am Pr said she would turn her out of doors how do you suppose I felt I went around

as if there could not be a God I felt as if
I could only have died before I met you I
am so thaneful there is a just God
Oh Willip Gussy and Charley knew they
would plead for me you told me you
would marry me when you was here and
said get the ring cut in two never mind the
ring the one you have of mine will do for the
take of your dead wife and my father and my

Billroy's at Forest at Forest & trait down
main street she is a friend of mine and we

on Friday 12th come in the after noon you can
stay all night or go home which ever you
like but I would like you to stay please to
come and you never will or shall be sorry
if I can help it do not fail me but trust
in God and do right then all will be right
there is no one that loves you so much as I do
I know I can trust you for you told me I could
I have stayed with pa with and got the black
horse for you and if you like I will get the
buggy and single harness for you I will
be here to see you walk so much you are getting
to old I would like to take care of you
for if you die I do not want to live I will die
long before you Miss Watson said her pa would
like me to come down I do not know what
for I would not like to go until after we are
married do not tell him I told you please to
come on Friday 12 you will feel better and it will
be heaven to me you can go home like a man
and not feel afraid of anyone and I will pay
