

Brisson Street Dec. 5th 1841.

My dear Brother

A few days ago we received
your letter dated November 21st last.
We hope the great Spirit has directed you to take
the step you have, and our prayers
to God is that you may continue to
be made happy by the love
of God in your hearts.

Mouhuk duk weengoo ninde naindah.
Min, Keshpim namahhedawah gwain
neegon enukhayaah, egewh nwaakpe
nukh nagooq whgah me cheguh meewene^{me}
Kahween ego ukhwindish kedah weejee
wahdeewog. Pakmah duk ~~kegeh~~^{kegeh} ka nemahwog.

Meewene go euk kuhya neenukhwind
anaindukamong euk ukhwin che
zahgeedeyung, Kahgenig che baghe
gung mahmin kedanahmin.

Last Monday we had a good Missionary
Meeting in Toronto, the Honorable R. B.
Sullivan, the Head Chief of Sir George Arthur's
Council took the Chair. The Collections
and Subscriptions taken at that Meeting
amounted to about 800 Dollars, from

this you will see that the forsaken
Canada Conference, is not forsaken
by God, nor by the great people in
Toronto. The Governor's Secretary Mr.
Garrison the next day sent ten dollars
in a letter, saying that he was sorry
that business had prevented him from
attending the Missionary Meeting.

I am sorry to inform you that
it will be out of my power to visit
you this winter. I am to visit the
lower part of this province during
the winter for the purpose of
attending Missionary Meetings, and I
shall be gone from home two months
and a half. I intend to start from
home on the 4th January next.

The hymn books are ready for you,
but how are they to be taken to you?
If I have an opportunity to send them
to Murrays town I shall do so. Are
not some of your people coming to
Toronto this winter?
