

Janesville Mission,  
March 10<sup>th</sup>, 1852.

My dear Friend,

I wrote to you some weeks ago, but have not received any answer. I now again write you a few lines to inform you that I am still alive and in good health. - I would fain hope that you and family are the same. I do not think that I shall stay long here. It was with feelings of great reluctance that I left home. Few days ago I received a letter from my father informing me that he has been very sickly ever since Christmas and that he was living all alone. My Brother and Sisters left home last summer and have not yet return home. Henry Jackson is here now on this Mission called Charkahning or Janesville, his wife is pretty well but he himself is still exceedingly weak, not able to do much as yet. He has been very sick that it was thought that he would not recover. He was first taken sick on the

month of November, <sup>and</sup> or to this present time, Jacob Jackson has also been sick for some weeks past but I believe is now well, his family is however very well, The Indians continue to ramble about as their fathers or grandfathers have done in times that are past and gone, I sometimes feel some doubt about the rise and progress of the Indians they still love the old mode of living customs manners &c &c It seems almost impossible for them to abandon it - I have very few children in School at present Most of them are gone making sugar, I find it exceedingly difficult to make the children in this place understand, I have to interpret or explain it to them in Indian, But the children at New Credit are not so, If I should return home soon I think I will come through your residence (S.C.) I hope you will write to me as soon as you conveniently can, Direction
