Memorandum.

Whereas the Chiefs Joshua and David Kawanoosh being duly authorized to act for the Mississauga Indians of Sarnia have this day personally agreed to surrender to Her Majesty the Land to be sold for the benefit of the Tribe, a certain portion of their Reserve adjoining the Town Plot of Sarnia. And it being the desire of the Tribe that although the Reserve is common property, the Chiefs Salt and David Kawanoosh who now are in occupation of the lots in question should receive some special advantage from this arrangement, and furthermore the Tribe being anxious to give a token of their gratitude for the long services of the Kawanoosh family, it is hereby provided by and with the consent of His Excellency the Governor General.

1st That after the said Land shall have been Surveyed into Town lots the said Salt and David Kawanoosh shall be permitted to select one lot each (not being a water lot) and that they shall respectively receive Patents for the same.

2nd That the Interest on the invested proceeds of the land sales shall until it has reached the annual sum of One hundred Pounds be divided between the said Chiefs Salt and David Kawanoosh in the proportion of one fourth to the former and three fourths to the latter, and that they shall continue in the enjoyment of the same during the term of their natural lives, after which these several amounts will revert to the Tribe, the wife of Salt and she surviving him to enjoy his share for her life. Interest over and above the said one hundred Pounds
to be appropriated to the uses of the Tribe.

3rd That Interpreter Black shall be permitted to select
one Town lot /not a water lot/ and to receive a Plot
for the same free of charge.

His Excellency the Governor General is pleased
to sanction these proposals, provided that they are
~~agreed to by the Indians at the General Council~~.
