Toronto 15<sup>th</sup> July 1856.

Sir

Referring to my Circular of the 26<sup>th</sup> May last and your reply of the 28<sup>th</sup> instant, I am directed to instruct you to explain to the Indians in Council under your superintendance, that hence forward any Indian, whether a Chief or not who shall be a party to any private bargain with any person for the sale of timber or land shall be liable to forfeit the share of Annuity, or other monies, which would be otherwise payable to him -
