Council held Today at 3. 0. Clock
P. M.

Chiefs present

John Sumner, Joseph Kawmunk
Elyah George, and Selas Mah-
hemong.

Chief Sumner opened the
Council for business and made
an opening speech by giving
comments on the visit & the re-
plies made by the distinguished
visitor. Mr Van Koughnet the
Sup^t General of Indian Affairs
Ottawa,

Moved by Albert Rodd Seco-
-ded Wm Shabemais, to reprove Mr
Watson for hiring a hard master
to oversee the ditching of the Reserve

Moved by Wilson Jacob seconded
by James Menas Sr. to ask Mr
Watson to be kind enough not to
do any thing concerning Pond
matters, without consulting the
Indians first carried.

Moved by Wilson Jacob seconded
by Peter Rodd to give \$20⁰⁰ to
Daniel Kahomabin out of the
gravel money (\$75⁰⁰) taken
from his lot. — carried

Moved by James Menas Jr.
Seconded by Peter Rodd to take
the balance of the gravel money
\$55⁰⁰ to improve the road run-
ning north south a long side of
the School house. Carried

Moved & seconded that the money
of received for gravel be applied
to the road only, mentioned above.

Moved By Peter Rodd Seconded by
Nicholas Plain to ask the Chief
^{John Sumner} James Menas and Wilson Jacobs
to see Mr Vaulough net about
the School. —
