to do with one living in Canada
maybe you want to help those
Indians at others if so let me know
at once cause they are after the same
property and those papers ought to
ben in Washington

by the first of June but you have
delayed me very near month
The petition oughte enter the
indian deparment the first sure
case the Congress will be through
by June for some time
now so please get through as soon
as you can

if I had money I would come my
self as same just like the^s of the Indians
I have not got suf money to
spare money is very scarce just now
now I have told you all
please send the petition
as soon as you can
