Dear Brother

As a Long time since
You have sold our Lands, I
am much in want I have Exp^d
Money from You this Long
time past, & I hope You will send
me a part this fall by the Mail
which there is no difficulty in
doing I shall be satisfied with
100 Dollars this fall Next Summer
probably I shall go and see You
& settle the Balance, I should
have went to Monatoolin if
I had been aware of Your being
there I w^ont last Year Exp^d

To see You & You did not come &
I thought You would not come
this Year therefore I did not go, it
was a long time before I heard You
had sold the land the governor was
the first to tell me
