

I hereby deny the claims made by different bands or parties from different places at the United States and some of them in Canada, who may ought whatever belonging solely to the Sassia Band of Acheaway Indians residing in the Indian Reserves, and which was set apart for their use and their Children, in the year ~~1825~~ ¹⁸²⁴ in the names of ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~people~~ ^{people} ~~who~~ ^{who} ~~emigrated~~ ^{emigrated} since the treaty in the year April 26th 1825, with the understanding that no foreigners will be admitted into the band. And since then many families has been emigrated from the United States and others have been moved into the Band Walpole Island

and forming themselves
with the few families belonging
to Walpole Island. who did
now making disturbances
in making false claims belong-
ing to the Garnia Band.

The following names are the
original members now residing
at Walpole Island on Buckheart
Baktansung. Osee wife. Yammatt
Kookoosh. Akkukkoogish. Wan-
be gosh. Noodinukum. (his son)
Kahye gemash (his son) Osha Oye
meak's family and few others. The
rest of them did not come to the
Island till lately. Therefore I
consider them as intruders in
our rights - by claiming our lands
which was reserved for ourselves
and our children - and the annu-
ties.

I hereby I hereby appoint
Joseph Wawarosh one of my
sons to succeed my office
as Chief of the Band of the
Chippeway Indians. As a fit and
proper person to take the position
as Chief of the Chippeway Indians
at Sabina - as I consider him
a man of good character &
a person worthy of such a
position among his Tribe -
and also I give the possession
to him all the documents
into his hands belonging to
the Tribe -

The understanding I got from
Earl of Elgin then Governor General
of British North America, that in
case I may die before my wife
Eliza Wawarosh that she shall re-
ceive half of my Salary - as pension
for life - and wish to secure of

the same, on account of my
feeble health - and that she
takes of the property belonging to
me -
