My Dear Uncle

My father requests me to write
you to say that he has for sometime been
expecting an answer to his last letter, and
is very anxious to hear from you, he
has been very bad for this sometime past
with the ague, John Simpson's young
sons are now playing the same game
that yours has or trying to do with you
wishing to put him out of his Chiefdom
when men get so vile as to debate themselves
by using all kind of underhand work
it is a despicable thing to the Community they
belong, in your case you are sober &
have your wits about you, not so with
poor John he unfortunately allows himself
to be led astray by Drink, which will
give his enemies as I may so call them

as I am rather in a hurry to write
